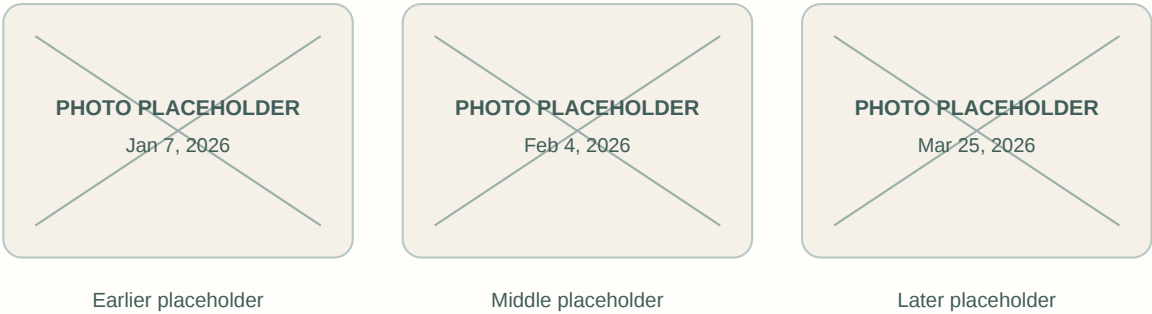

Photos in a real patient export would remain patient-selected and patient-reported. A photo comparison cannot diagnose a condition, prove that a treatment caused a change, or replace a clinician's examination.

Reading this sample

The report preserves what the patient recorded: dates, statuses, notes, visible missing periods, and questions. It does not reinterpret missing records or turn them into a medical conclusion.

The sample is designed to support a conversation. Diagnosis, prescribing, treatment instructions, and clinical interpretation stay with the care team.
